Grass Cutting Services

The Holly Springs Housing Authority grass cutting season begins April 1, 2024 through October 31, 2024. We will start charging a lawn service fee of \$15.00 on April 1, 2024. Every household with the exception of the elderly, disabled or tenant who pay ceiling rent will incur an additional charge of \$15.00 each month. Effective immediately it is imperative that all tenants keep their yards free of debris and litter.

2024 Parking Decals

The 2024 Parking Decals for vehicles were issued to tenants during recertification. If you did not receive a decal, please call the office immediately. You must have your car registration with you in order to get a decal. Residents are allowed to register no more than one (1) vehicle per dwelling unit. Parking spaces are not available for more than one vehicle. Replacement for lost, stolen or removed parking decals is subject to a charge of \$20.00 Decals must be placed on the front lower left hand (driver) side of the windshield. Remember if you do not have a yellow 2024 parking decal your vehicle is subject to be towed.

Sewage Backup

We are having problems with sewage backup on all properties. Pouring grease, putting toys, sanitary napkins, hair weave, toilet deodorizer, and other items down your drains is considered tenant abuse. This cause major backup in the sewage line and eventually it will back up in your apartment. If a work order is called in and this is the problem, the tenant will pay any expenses incurred.

Lost Garbage Cans

If you do not have a trash can, or was not issued one by the utility department when you changed the service into your name, please call 662-252-4652 and select the option (2) for the utility department. The Housing Authority is not responsible for keeping up with your trash cans. Please do not put your trash in another tenant trash can without their approval.
