CAR PARKING DECALS

Authority parking rules will be enforced on all properties. If you are parked in a parking space with no (RED 2025) parking decal your vehicle will be towed at your expense. If you have purchased a new vehicle you need to bring the information for the new vehicle to the office. The old vehicle sticker will be voided and a new one issued. If you have lost your sticker there will be \$20.00 fee for a replacement sticker. There is a problem with vehicles blocking tenants in their parking spaces, if your vehicle is blocking tenants in, it will be towed at your expense. Tenants are responsible for informing their visitors.

Tips To Eliminate Bugs & Rodents in Your Home

- Keep your home clean by wiping up crumbs and spills immediately, washing dirty dishes daily. Storing food (including pet food) in airtight containers
- Take out trash regularly and ensure bins have tight-fitting lids.
- Remove Clutter (newspapers, cardboard, clothing or debris) where bugs and rodents can hide and breed.
- Clean Pet bedding weekly and manage pet waste promptly.
- Report leaky pipes or faucets to the office to cut off pests' access to water sources.

Important Reminders

We are required to file eviction each month for current month unpaid balances. Therefore, all balances should be paid in a timely manner to avoid an eviction.

- Rent is due on the 1st of each month
- Late fees apply after 12:00 a.m. on the 5th
- Late fees apply after 12:00 a.m. on the 15th
- Evictions will be filed on the 25th
- The No Cash policy is in effect. All rent must be paid by Money Order or Cashier's Check only.
- All Changes in family income and composition must be reported to the Housing Authority within 10 days of occurrence. Failure to do so will result in retroactive rent payment and may result in termination of your lease.
- If you put your rent payment in the rent payment, drop box, <u>please do not fold your payment</u> <u>envelope</u>. Folding your envelope will cause it to get stuck, which will not allow other tenants to put their payment in the rent drop box.
- If door knobs are loose, please call in a work order for repair. If door knobs are missing there will be a \$10.00 charge to replace.
- Please make sure maintenance can access the hot water heater closet.
- Do not **block windows** with furniture.

GARBAGE

Take pride in your community, and do your part in keeping your dwelling unit and surrounding area free from garbage and debris. Each resident is required to keep trash and garbage in front, behind, and on the side of your apartment picked up. Rugs should not be left hanging on clothes lines, nor should other items be stored on your back porch. It is your responsibility to pull your garbage can to the curb for pick-up and to the back of your apartment beside your back porch the same day of pick-up. Furniture and large items can only be placed out on Tuesday night as maintenance goes to the dump on Wednesday. If you are missing a trash can, please do not call waste-management, call the Holly Springs Housing Authority office at 662-252-2971.
